Directions (Ages 6+)

Roll one die three times.

Roll #1 – Character:

Roll #2 – Setting:

Roll again and choose the setting from the matching box.

Roll #3 – Problem:

Roll once more and choose the problem in that box.

Now use your character + setting + problem to write your own story on a separate sheet of paper.

★ Optional “6+ Extras” (age-appropriate challenges)

Add at least one sentence that starts with the word

“Because.”

(Encourages deeper thinking.)

Write 5–8 complete sentences.

(Good structure goal for this age.)

Include dialogue using quotation marks.

(Perfect challenge for 6–9.)

Add a creative ending:

Happy, silly, surprising — your choice!
